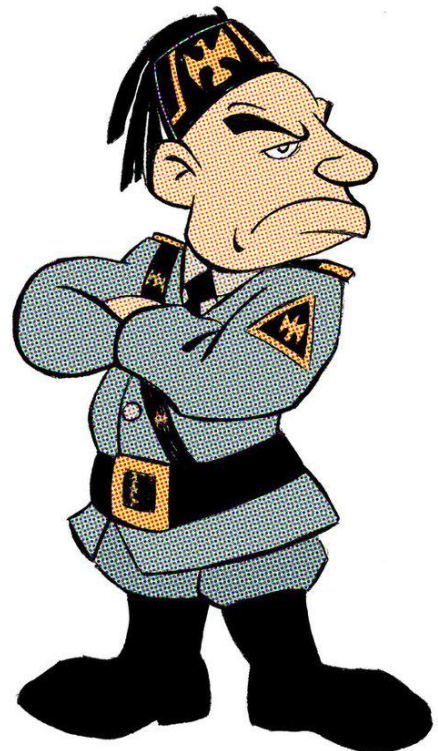
Skills and Processes:

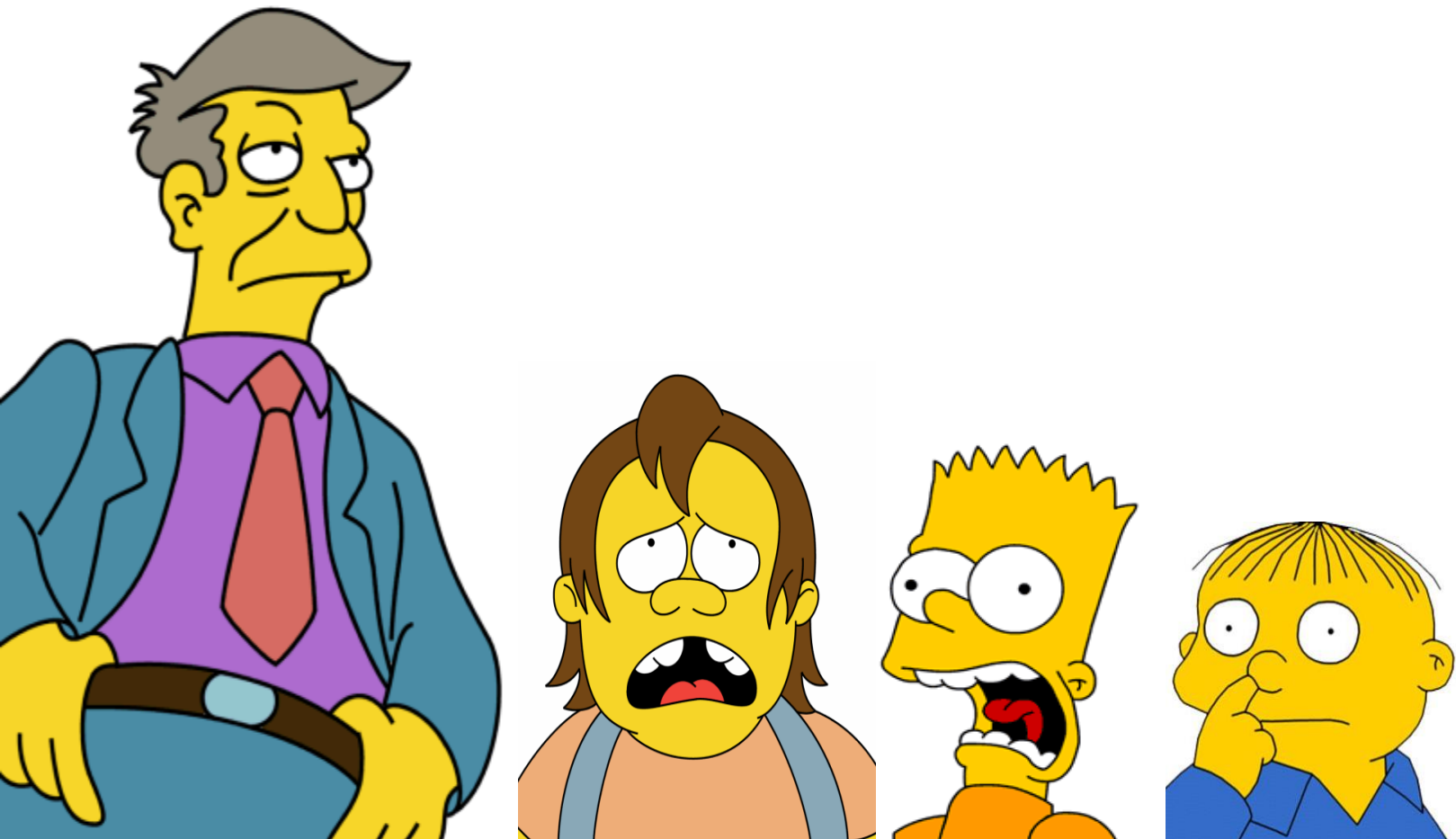
